Guidelines

PUBLIC PRESENTATIONS

Project Talk

- Junior – Ages 7 – 13
- 7-minute maximum time limit
- Tells about your actual project experience
- Purpose is to inform
- Visuals aids may be used but are not required
- *Two (2) 4-Hers can advance to Regional Day*

Demonstrations & Illustrated Talks

- Junior – Ages 7 – 13
- Senior – Ages 14 and older
- 10-minute maximum time limit Junior Division
- 15-minute maximum time limit Senior Division
- Tells or shows “how”
- Purpose is to teach
- Visuals aids will be used
- *Two (2) 4-Hers from each Age Division can advance to Regional Day*

Public Speaking

- Senior – Ages 14 and older
- 15-minute maximum time limit
- Topic may be of any interest to the 4-Her
- Visuals aids may be used but are not required
- Outline is required for the judge
- *Two (2) 4-Hers can advance to Regional Day*

Model Meeting

- Up to 32 participants; any ages
- Up to 35 minutes allowed; Roll Call excluded; Recreation included
- Clubs are encouraged to plan a model meeting that depicts a typical monthly meeting of their 4-H club.
- An agenda of the model meeting must be presented to the judge before the meeting is called to order.
- During the model meeting, the secretary should take notes. After the meeting the secretary must turn in the model meeting notes.
- Parliamentary problem will be provided 10-minutes early.
- *One (1) club can advance to Regional Day*

Mock Interview

- Senior – Ages 14 and older
- 15-minute maximum time limit
- Members will select a job they see themselves applying for in the next 6 – 8 years.
- One week prior to Club Day, members must submit an electronic copy of the following to the Extension Office:
 - Resume – list current qualifications, education, training and/or recognition
 - Cover Letter – outline general duties of the job, background knowledge you possess to be a good candidate for the chosen job, any additional training/education you will need to be a successful candidate, and any additional information you wish to share about yourself and/or the position
- At 4-H Club Day, members will participate and be judged in an actual interview where you are evaluated on all of the key elements of an interview process.
- *Not a Regional Day Event*

TALENT – MUSIC

Must supply judge with original copy of music
Must number the measures on the music

Chorus

- Each Chorus will perform two (2) musical numbers of their own choosing.
- Chorus composed of 16 or more from 1 club or a composite group from 2 clubs
- Original copy of selections will be given to judge prior to performance.
- Accompanist does not need to be a 4-H member.
- It is recommended the selections be memorized.
- *One (1) Chorus can advance to Regional Day*

Vocal Ensemble

- Each Vocal Ensemble will perform two (2) musical numbers of their own choosing.
- Club or composite group from 2 or more clubs, or 2 or more participants
- Original copy of selections will be given to judge prior to performance
- Accompanist does not need to be a 4-H member.
- It is recommended the selections be memorized.
- *One (1) Vocal Ensemble can advance to Regional Day*

Vocal Solo

- Participant will perform one (1) musical number
- All ages
- Original copy of selection will be given to judge prior to performance
- Accompanist does not need to be a 4-H member.
- It is recommended the selection be memorized
- *One (1) Vocal Solo can advance to Regional Day*

Orchestra or Band

- Each Orchestra/Band will perform two (2) musical numbers of their own choosing
- Club or composite group from 2 or more clubs, consisting of 16 or more youth
- Original copy of selections will be given to judge prior to performance
- *One (1) Orchestra or Band can advance to Regional Day*

Instrumental Ensemble

- Each Instrumental Ensemble will perform two (2) musical numbers of their own choosing
- Club or composite group from 2 or more clubs; 2 – 15 participants
- Original copy of selections will be given to judge prior to performance
- *One (1) Instrumental Ensemble can advance to Regional Day*

Instrumental Solo

- Participant will perform one (1) number
- All ages
- Original copy of selection will be given to judge prior to performance
- It is recommended the selection be memorized.
- *One (1) Instrumental Solo can advance to Regional Day*

Piano Solo

- Participant will perform one (1) number
- Junior – Ages 7 – 13
- Senior – Ages 14 and older
- Original copy of selection will be given to judge prior to performance
- It is recommended the selection be memorized.
- *One (1) 4-Her from each Age Division can advance to Regional Day*

TALENT – DANCE

Individual, Small Group, Medium Group, Large Group

- All ages
- Small Group – 2 – 4 participants
- Medium Group – 5-12 participants
- Large Group – 13 or more participants
- Each group is limited to 5 minutes performing time
- *One (1) 4-Her from each Dance Group size can advance to Regional Day*

TALENT – DRAMA and OTHER

Creative Drama

- All ages
- Any number of participants
- Limited to 15 minutes performing time
- Costumes, props, theatricals acceptable
- *One (1) Creative Drama can advance to Regional Day*

Skit

- All ages
- Any number of participants
- Limited to 5 minute performing time
- *One (1) Skit can advance to Regional Day*

Reading

- Junior – Ages 7 – 13
- Senior – Ages 14 and older
- Limited to 5 minutes performing time
- Memorization optional
- No costumes, props, theatricals allowed
- *One (1) Reading from each Age Division can advance to Regional Day*

Other Talent (novelty, stunt, puppets, marionettes, ventriloquist, etc.)

- All ages
- Limited to 5 minute performing time
- May be individual or group
- *One (1) Other Talent can advance to Regional Day*

Cloverbuds

- Ages 5 - 6
- Limited to 5 minute performing time
- *Not a Regional Day Event*

Show and Tell

- Ages 7 – 8
- Limited to 3 minute performing time
- *Not a Regional Day Event*

PERISHABLE FOOD

Perishable Food

- Junior – Ages 7 – 13
- Senior – Ages 14 and older
- Maximum 2 food item entries
- Enter only perishable food items.
- Recipe must be included with the food item at consultation judging.
- Entry will be judged by consultation evaluation with the 4-H member present. Parents and leaders are welcome to listen.
- You should be prepared to discuss the nutritional knowledge of the food product.
- Participant is responsible for containers and dishes.
- Food will be temperature checked for safety:
 - Hot food should be held at 140°F or warmer.
 - Cold food should be held at 40°F or below.
 - Temperature danger zone: 40°F to 140°F.
 - Bacteria grow fast in the temperature danger zone.
 - Avoid keeping food within the danger zone.
 - Perishable food should not be left out more than 2 hours at room temperature (1 hour when the temperature is above 90°F).
- Perishable Foods are those that spoil quickly and require refrigeration or a freezer.
- *Not a Regional Day Event*
